Dear Justice Edmead:

I am writing on behalf of the Superintendent of Financial Services of the State of New York in her capacity as Liquidator ("Liquidator") of Health Republic Insurance of New York, Corp. ("Health Republic") to provide an update on the projected timeline ("Timeline") of milestones in the Health Republic liquidation. The Timeline is attached hereto as Appendix A and is posted on Health Republic's website.

- On August 7, 2017, the Liquidator issued the first explanations of benefits/allowance ("EOBs") to members and providers. The EOBs are being issued on a rolling basis and will generally be sent in the order of older to more recent dates of service. The first grouping of EOBs starts with the 2014 claims year.
- As set forth in the Claims Adjudication Procedure approved by the Court on October 11, 2016, to the extent a provider or member disputes a determination contained in an EOB, the provider or member has 60 days from the date of the EOB to submit an appeal. The Liquidator has set up an electronic portal on the Health Republic website <http://www.healthrepublicny.org/info.php> for members and providers to submit appeals. Appeals may also be mailed to:

- The Liquidator has completed the 2016 financial audit of Health Republic and has posted it on the Health Republic website.

This timeline is presented as a reference for the Court and Health Republic's claimants. All projections are estimates, subject to change, and do not present a complete discussion of the numerous steps and processes that must occur in the course of the liquidation.
